The Chicago National Association of Dance Masters will award \$5,000 in scholarships at the Summer Workshop to members or students of a member in good standing in 2022. They will be awarded to four individuals at the following levels: \$2,000, \$1,500, \$1,000 and \$500. The selection will be made by a committee based on the following guidelines: **Applications must be received by June 30, 2022.**

- 1. To apply, you must be a member or a student of a member (members must have paid 2022 dues).

 Past scholarship recipients may re-apply if they are members or students of members in good standing.
- 2. You must be enrolled in the 2022 Training School, Dance & More or National Ballet Forum. You will be observed in class and your classwork will count for *40 percent*.
- 3. You must be currently enrolled in college with a major or minor in dance. You must provide an original transcript of your grades and your academic performance will count for 25 percent. You must be in your second year or more as a dance major/minor.
- 4. You must provide a video of 3 to 5 minutes of your individual work in two or more disciplines (In-studio video preferred—it does not have to be a formal performance). This video will count for **25 percent**.
- 5. You will be interviewed by the scholarship committee. Interviews will be scheduled during the workshop and will count for *10 percent*.
- 6. Each applicant must submitt a brief essay about your dance history, what dance means to you and how it will be a part of your future. In addition to dance, tell us about yourself: your hobbies, what is important in your life, your goals and dreams.
- 7. The financial award will be sent directly to the named college/university.
- Materials may be submitted online at www.cnadm.com/scholarships. Submit this application, essay, original transcript copy, optional photo, and a 3-5 minute video of an in-studio performance.
